TRIAL SITE & INFORMATION

The show site is indoors on athletic turf. Please bring your own crate, mat, clean up supplies, & water for your dog.
All dogs must be on leash at all times, except when in the ring.
Exercise and toilet your dog in designated areas.
Please poop and scoop and use garbage containers on the site. Please be courteous to others using the area.
No aggressive dogs.
A warm up jump will be provided for all exhibitors
Event set up available starting at 6:30 am on Saturday, October 19, 2024. **EXHIBITORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO THE BUILDING PRIOR TO 6:30 AM.**

TRIAL SITE RULES

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating

arrangements for space, safety or site requirements. Seating is allowed on the floor. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their space. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight at the show site. X-pens allowed.

UKI TRIAL INFORMATION YOU MAY FIND HELPFUL....

MEASURING

- All registered dogs are measured free of charge. All trials must have an official measuring device by their second trial. All newly registered dogs or a dog without a permanent measure, not jumping full height (24", 22", 20" select) must be measured by a UKI judge or approved UKI measurer to determine the dog's jump height.
- All handlers are solely responsible for the behavior of their dogs including during measuring. If there is doubt as to how a dog will react towards the measurer, the dog will need to wear a muzzle while being measured. Handlers must prevent any aggressive behavior during measuring.
- A 1st measurement must be obtained and sent to the UKI office by the dog's 3rd trial. A measurement from another organization may be used for this first measure if it is an actual measurement and is not within .25" (6mm) of a jump height cut off.
- A 2nd measure must be obtained between 12 months and by a maximum of 18 months after the dog's first recorded measurement. If this timeframe is not met, the dog is unable to compete at any UKI event until this is done.
- If a newly registered dog is aged three years and older, the dog will only need one measurement, and this must be by a UKI measurer. No other organization's measure may be used for this. If a dog is found to have achieved results when it has not complied with the measurement rules, all results that have been gained while breaking these rules will be void and any progression will be rescinded.
- Dogs will be measured using official measuring devices while the dog is placed in a standing stacked position on a flat surface such as a table. The measurement is taken from the perpendicular line from the highest point at the top of the dog's withers to the flat surface. At the time of measuring, the measurement will be recorded and sent to the UKI office.
- If there is a controversy over the dog's permanent measurement, then the owner/handler may ask for an appointed UKI official to re-measure the dog's height. If this 3rd measure agrees with the permanent measurement, keeping them in the same height category, the handler may not challenge their permanent measure again. If the 3rd measure does not agree with the current jump height category, a 4th measure must be obtained. If available, this should be at the same trial but by a different UKI measurer. If the 4th measure cannot be done on the same day as the 3rd, then the dog must stay at the current jump height listed on their UKI account until this last measurement is obtained. This 4th measure will be the deciding factor. No further challenges will be accepted, including those where another organization has measured differently.

COURSE WALK THROUGHS

It is the competitor's responsibility to be aware of what is happening in the rings and be ready for your course walk throughs. All jump heights will walk at the same time. For example when the Novice Speed Stakes course is up for walking – all heights, including the Select Options will walk. Call Sheets- Each class will have call sheets located at the ring. Please check in for your class by ticking your name only when you have walked the course.

RUNNING

It is the competitor's responsibility to know what is going on in the ring. When your jump height is running in your class you must be ready to run.

MOVING UP

Beginners to Novice – Equivalent of 3 clear rounds (12 points, 8 from agility)

Novice to Senior – Equivalent of 5 clear rounds (20 points, 12 from agility, 4 from jumping, 4 from games)

Senior to Champ – Equivalent of 9 clear rounds (36 points, 12 from agility, 12 from jumping, 12 from games)

UKI does next day move ups!

If you gain enough points on at a trial, you must move up to the next level on the next day or trial. If it is the second day of a trial, please see the trial secretary to fill out a move up form.

Training Rounds – Not for Competition (NFC)

You may opt to make any run you have signed up for a "NFC" training Round for which you may bring in a non-audible toy into the ring. You may not use any food or clickers! You must state NFC prior to entering the ring. The Scribe will write NFC across your scribe ticket, and notify the judge. You will be given the course time to do what you wish. Listen out for the timer to yell "Time!" – You must immediately exit the ring – please stop the finish timing if electronic timing is used.

If you do not notify the judge and scribe ahead of time that you are doing NFC, you will not be able to not turn your run into a training round if you are faulted on course. Repeating any piece of equipment will be deemed training and the judge will ask you to leave the ring immediately if you do this.

CONFLICTS

If you have a conflict you must put a C beside your name to indicate this. We will make every effort to work you in prior to the class being closed out. If you do not pre check in, the class will close without you being able to run. So be sure to check in when you walk through!!!!

RESULTS

Once you have run, your scribe sheet will be sent to the scoring table. It is important that you check your scored result to be sure you agree with your result. If you think there is a problem, you will need to speak to the judge before he or she forgets your run. The judges' decision is final, so if you wait and the judge cannot remember your run, the scribe sheet will stand. Please remember that if the judge disagrees with you once you have stated your case, you must be a good sport and remember that the judge is only human and judging is still subjective. You will win some and you will lose some, but again the judges' decision is final.

Once all the heights within a class are finished, the results will be submitted to the show secretary by either downloading from computer scoring, or hand written results sheets, for sorting of level points and reading out for prize givings. The results will then be available for viewing by all competitors.
