TRIAL SET UP/BUILDING HOURS:

- Set up starts at 3:30 pm on Friday. We would greatly appreciate assistance.
- General building availability for all competitors is 7:00am Saturday and Sunday
- The building closes 30 minutes after judging ends.

NO DOGS MAY BE LEFT IN THE BUILDING OVERNIGHT.

TRIAL AND SITE REGULATIONS, AVAILABILITY & CRATING

- **Note:** BCFG is an on leash facility, the pens outside can no longer be used for off leash dogs.
- Paper Gate sheets will be used for check in and running. Results will be physically posted.
- Maps will be posted at www.BrinsonTrialServices.com the morning of each event. Posted map copies will also be available at the trial.

CRATING:

- Please be courteous with your set up. The aisle ways are narrow, and everyone should make an attempt to allow as much space for dogs and handlers to move about as possible. There is ample space available for crates and chairs, but not for extras like tables and excessive storage. The trial committee reserves the right to rearrange set ups if necessary to accommodate all participants.
- X-Pens are permitted, but size should be appropriate to the number of dogs within.
- Please remember to keep the exit ways more open, as everyone must pass through these areas, and they should have a space that lets them be comfortable doing so.
- Please respect "NO CRATING" areas.

FOOD AND REFRESHMENTS AT THE TRIAL

- No Food Vendor will be onsite for this event. Several food establishments are close by.
- Filtered water is available in the arena. Please bring your own water bottle.

MOVE UPS AND CLASS CHANGES

- From Chapter 1, Section 20: Move-Up entries will be accepted for dogs that have completed a title after the closing date. Email notification of move up or class change is acceptable, with return receipt verification from the secretary. Either Move Up forms or emails must be completed and delivered to the Trial Secretary prior to 6 PM on the Monday evening preceding the event. Move-up entries for Sunday

must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from. Dogs so moved up will run at the end of the running order. Move-ups can only be accepted if judging limits are not exceeded.

- Entry move-up valid only if the dog was already entered in the Event indicated and only if approved by the Trial Secretary. Dogs moved up will run at the end of the class running order.
Regulations for Agility Trials: Chapter 1, Section 21. Change of Entry. In addition to Move-ups as described in Chapter 1, Section 20 entries may also be changed as noted in this section. A dog which has been entered in a Novice "A" class for which it is not eligible to be entered in due to class restrictions on the dog or handler may be moved to the Novice "B" class under the following conditions:
- The request for the move must be in writing and presented to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. The request must state the reason and justification for the move from a Novice "A" class to the Novice "B" class.
- After the close of entries, a dog may be moved down in their class level (i.e., Master to Excellent). The request for the move to the class for which the dog is eligible must be in writing and submitted to the superintendent or trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- If a VMO or Field Representative at a trial measures a dog into a height other than what they entered, the entry may be changed from Regular to Preferred or from Preferred to Regular, as long as the dog has not run any classes that day. If the dog has already run, the change may be made for the next trial day(s). The exhibitor must provide the Trial Secretary the AKC Agility Measurement Form when requesting the class change.
- If your dog needs to be measured, there will be VMOs present at this trial.

DSA TRIAL HOURS & SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Set up: 3:30 pm Friday

The trial site opens at 7:00 am Saturday and Sunday. Judging starts at 8:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday. The site remains open until 30 minutes after conclusion of judging.

Classes will be judged in the following order.

Breaks may be called at the judge's discretion. Preliminary running order contingent on move-up entries not yet received and wait listed entry changes not yet received. (**Judges reserve the right to reorganize the schedule below to accommodate the needs of the trial**) "B" class dogs will run prior to "A" class dogs in the Novice classes, within height classifications, except where otherwise indicated. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for all exhibitors.
